Annual Physical Exam

Throughout the life of your pet, we want to be able to make recommendations to insure their long and healthy life. A specific vaccination protocol for your pet can be tailored to his/her lifestyle and environment. Diet, dental health and weight control are very important issues that reduce the risk of diabetes and arthritis.

We now require an annual physical exam prior to administering any vaccination, with the exception of the rabies vaccine. We strongly believe that an annual physical exam is every bit as important in maintaining good health as any vaccination. Blindly vaccinating an unhealthy animal is not only a waste of the owner's money, it is also detrimental to the health and well-being of our patients.
